## From DCE Randy & Board of Parish Ed

### LCMS NATIONAL YOUTH GATHERING—

We have been blessed with some generous special gifts from some of our members toward this event this summer. As we have some families with multiple children going, as well as some single parents with a child attending we're going to need all the help we can get!.

These Gatherings have been held for almost 40 years. I know personally that Bethel has attended since 1986 (and most likely in 1983 as well) and has sent over 200 youth and adults to these Gatherings over the years. Our flight leaves Hobby Airport at 6:45 AM on July 11<sup>th</sup>. We have contracted with Ground Shuttle services for transportation to the airport on the 11<sup>th</sup> and home on the 15<sup>th</sup>. Again, thanks for your continued support.



**The theme is “REAL. PRESENT. GOD”** centering on *“Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!” The Lord of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our fortress.” Psalm 46:10-11 ESV*

**FUNDRAISING** Our projected costs for the Gathering are \$1155/person (lodging, food, registration and transportation). This comes out to a little over \$30,000 for this event for the 26 youth. So far our fundraising, special gifts, parent payments and church contributions leave us with a little over \$5500 to have everyone paid for. (Nine of our youth have already earned or have parents kicked in enough to have their ways paid for). It is our goal to never have anyone not be able to attend because of a lack of finances.

We will start selling Christian themed t-shirts, caps, water bottles, children's shirts, etc. Sunday, May 5 and will be taking orders through Sunday, May 19. A display will be set up in the Narthex by May 5. 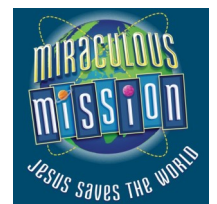

#### Miraculous Mission

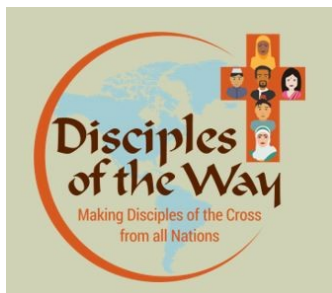

After lunch, Larry Piper reviewed Winston Groom's 2018 book, *The Allies: Roosevelt, Churchill, Stalin, and the Unlikely Alliance That Won World War II*.

Larry reviewed some basic facts about the war, described the very different origins and backgrounds of the leaders of the alliance and presented brief biographical information on each leader.

Larry then discussed interactions among the three men; pointing out that although the three leaders only met twice, they exchanged thousands of messages and had other meet-

ings at which two of the leaders were present. He read excerpts from the Prologue concerning their interactions at their first meeting—The Tehran Conference in 1943.

Larry discussed and compared the leader's leadership styles and pointed out that Churchill's post war "Iron Curtain Speech" at Fulton, Missouri resulted in the NATO Alliance which continues to the present.

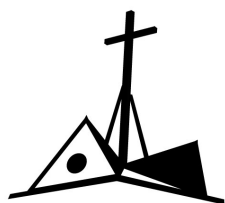
